

Underground and Surface Mines Can Be Hot Work Sites

- ✓ When possible, mine planning, ventilation, and air conditioning may reduce heat to acceptable levels.
- ✓ Provide frequent breaks and reasonably short work periods.
- ✓ Provide readily accessible, cooler rest areas.
- ✓ Provide cool drinking water near the workers and encourage water breaks.
- ✓ All workers should be provided heat stress training.
