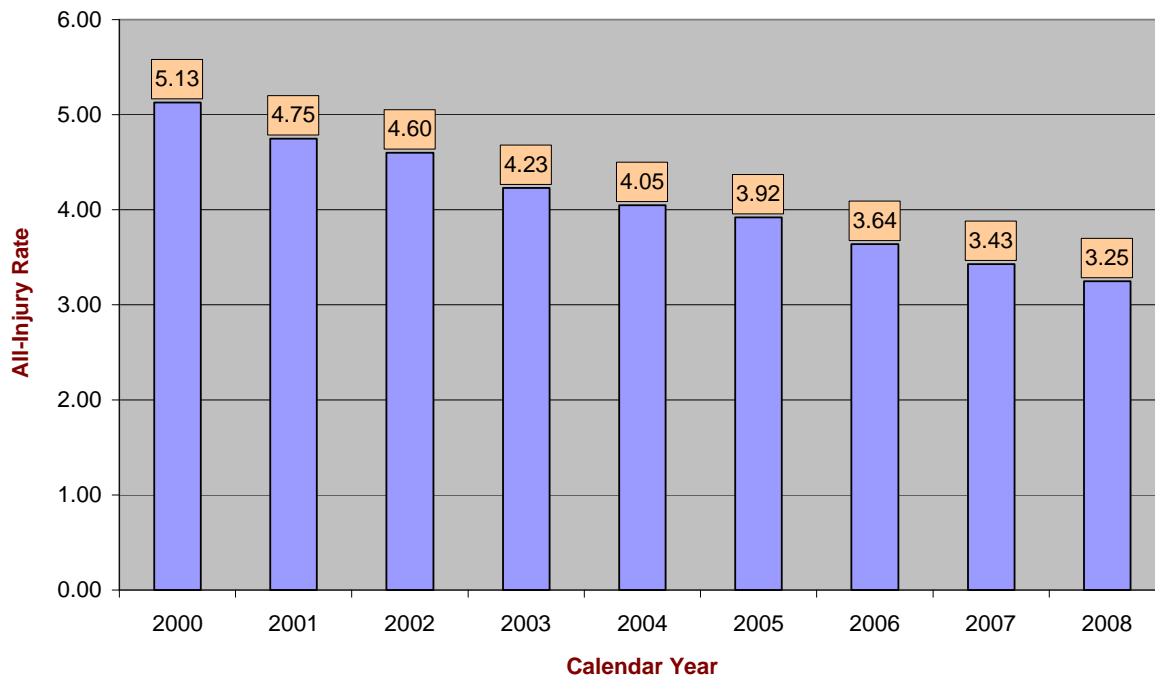


MSHA FACT SHEET: Mine All-Injury Rate¹ Both Coal and Metal/Non Metal Mines CY 2000 - CY 2008

All MSHA - All-Injury Rates CY 2000 - 2008

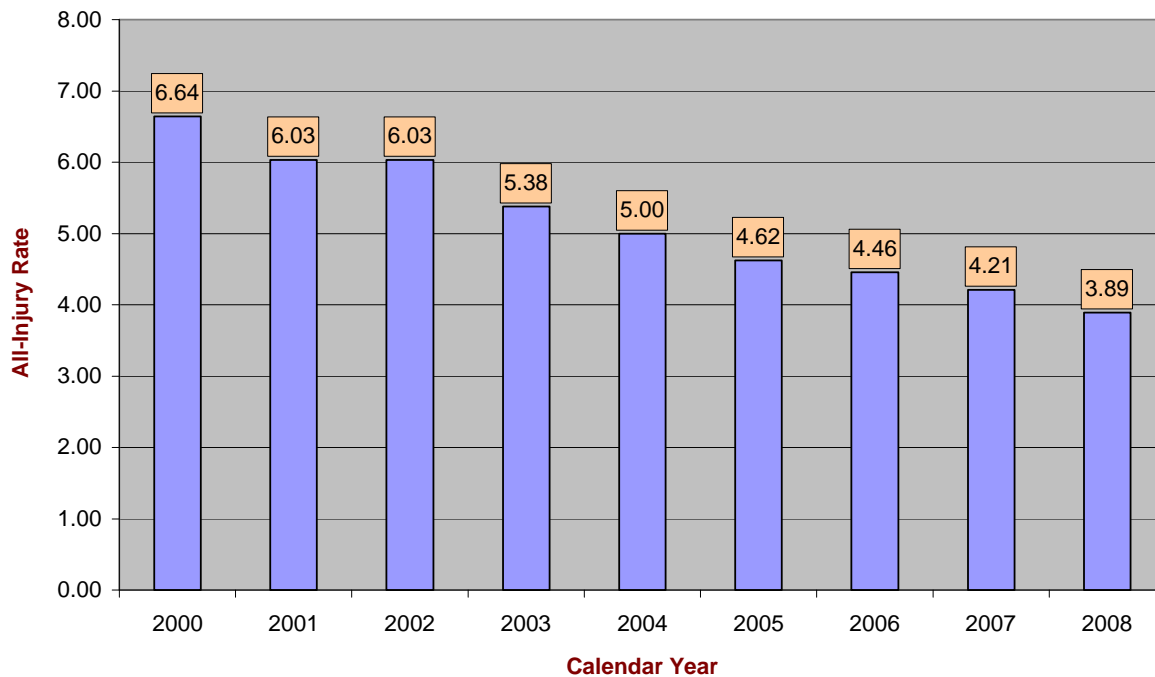


- The All-Injury Rate decreased 37 percent from 5.13 in CY 2000 to 3.25 in CY 2008.
- The All-Injury Rate decreased 11 percent from 3.64 in CY 2006 to 3.25 in CY 2008.

Coal - All-Injury Rates CY 2000 - 2008

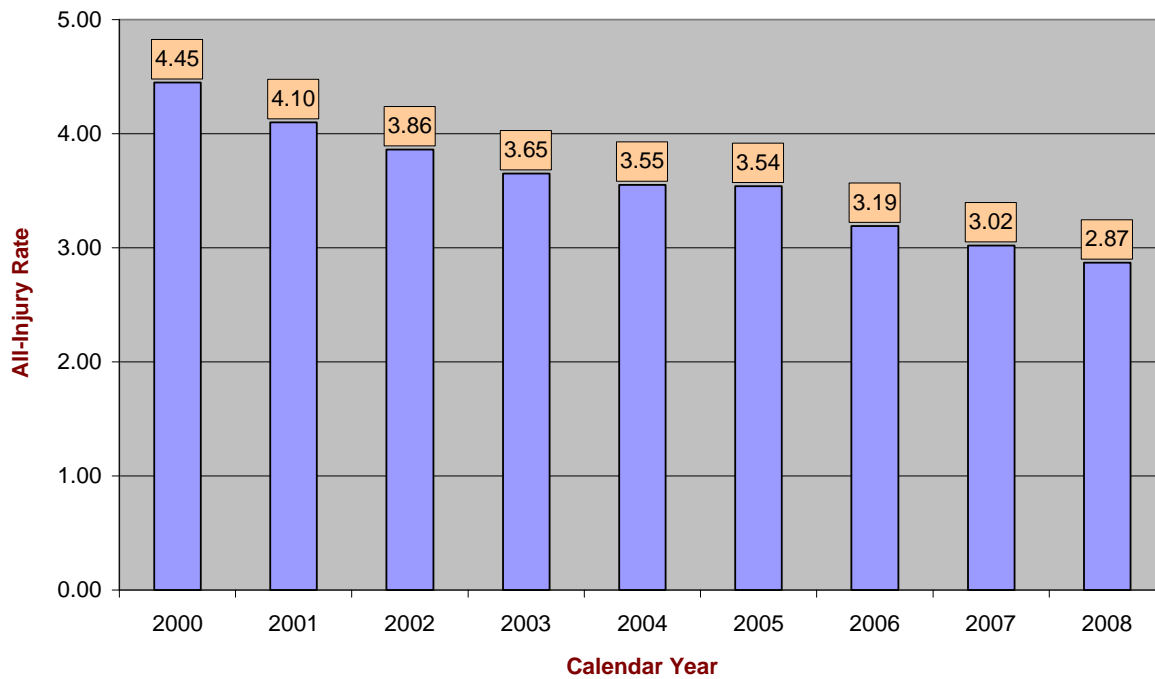


- The All-Injury Rate for Coal mines decreased 41 percent from 6.64 in CY 2000 to 3.89 in CY 2008.
- The All-Injury Rate for Coal mines decreased 13 percent from 4.46 in CY 2006 to 3.89 in CY 2008.

M/NM - All-Injury Rates CY 2000 - 2008



- The All-Injury Rate for MNM mines decreased 36 percent from 4.45 in CY 2000 to 2.87 in CY 2008.
- The All-Injury Rate for MNM mines decreased 10 percent from 3.19 in CY 2006 to 2.87 in CY 2008.
