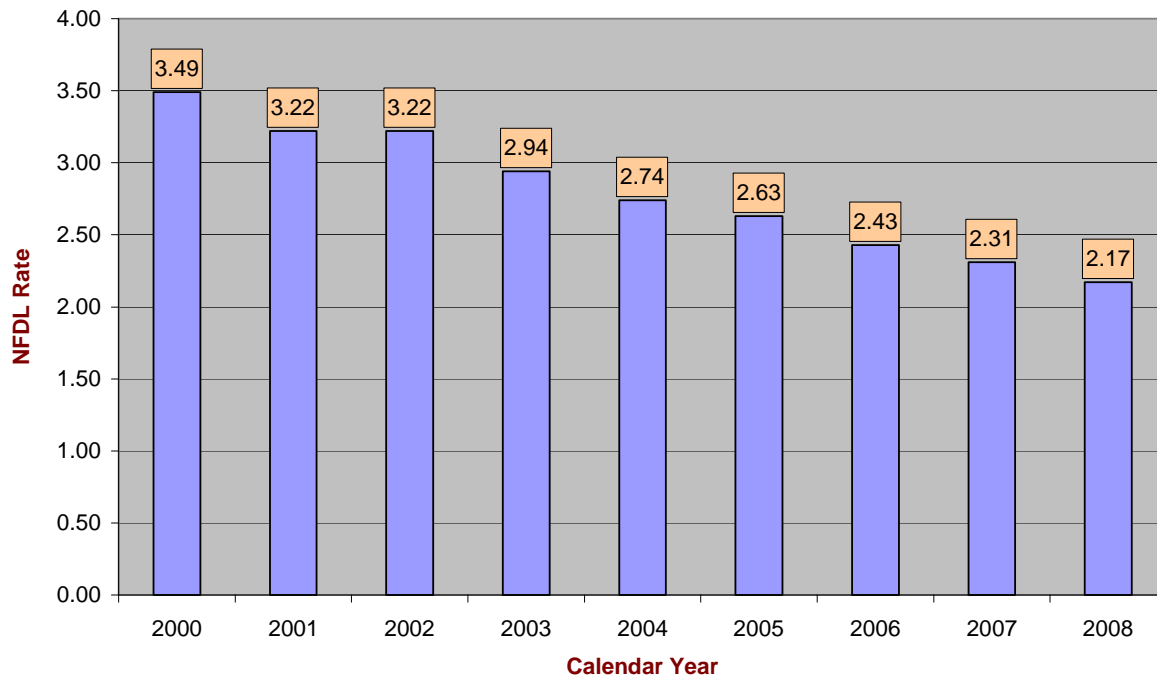

All MSHA - NFDL Rates CY 2000 - 2008

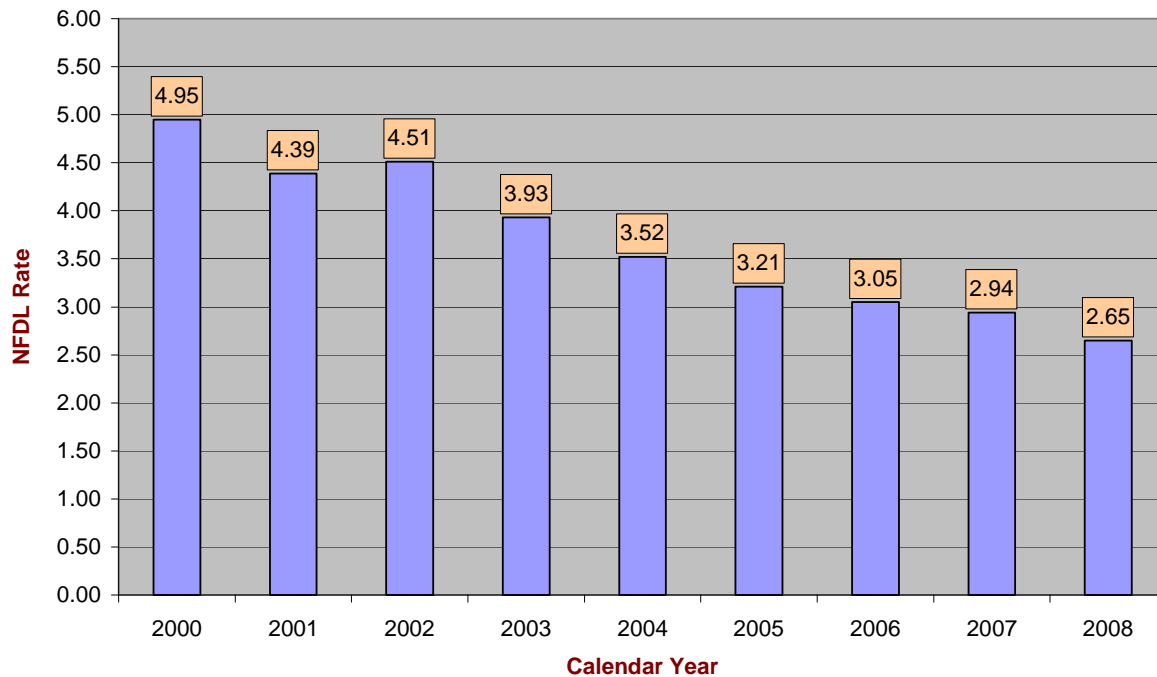


- The Non-Fatal Days Lost Rate decreased 38 percent from 3.49 in CY 2000 to 2.17 in CY 2008.
- The Non-Fatal Days Lost Rate decreased 11 percent from 2.43 in CY 2006 to 2.17 in CY 2008.

CY 2000 - 2008**

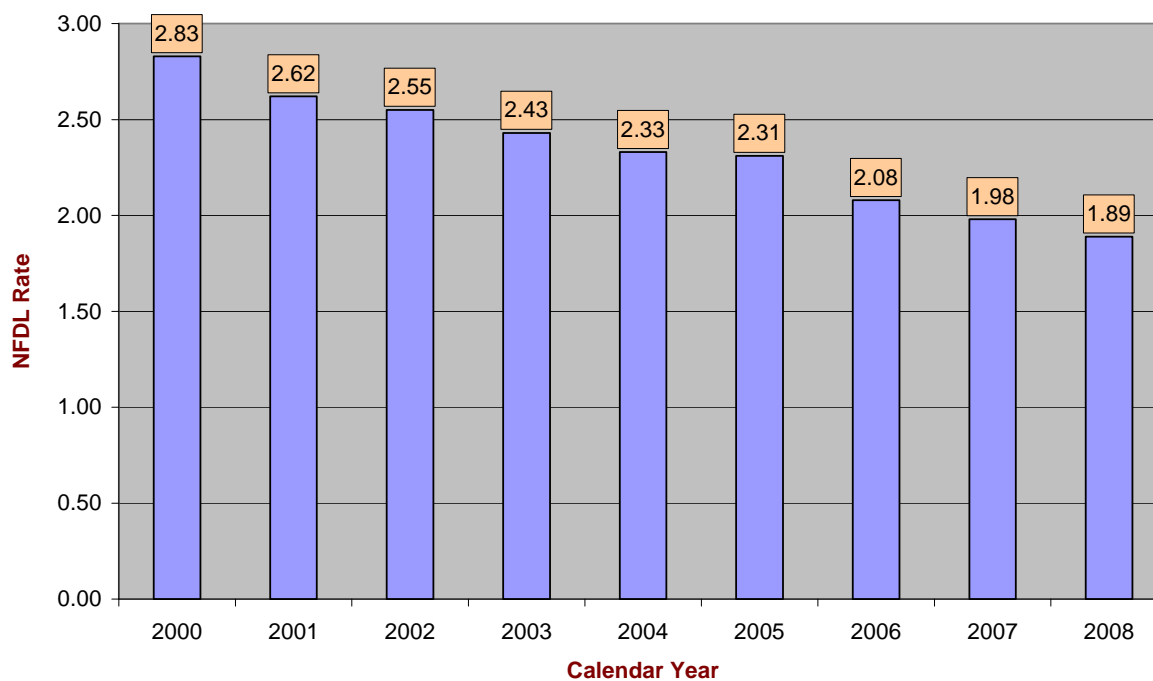


- The Non-Fatal Days Lost Rate for Coal mines decreased 46 percent from 4.95 in CY 2000 to 2.65 in CY 2008.
- The Non-Fatal Days Lost Rate for Coal mines decreased 13 percent from 3.05 in CY 2006 to 2.65 in CY 2008.

**M/NM - NFDL Rates
CY 2000 - 2008**



- The Non-Fatal Days Lost Rate for MNM mines decreased 33 percent from 2.83 in CY 2000 to 1.89 in CY 2008.
- The Non-Fatal Days Lost Rate for MNM mines decreased 9 percent from 2.08 in CY 2006 to 1.89 in CY 2008.
