

CY 2000 - 2007**




- The Fatality Rate declined 27 percent from .0272 in CY 2000 to .0199 in CY 2007.
- The Fatality Rate increased 9 percent from .0183 in CY 2005 to .0199 in CY 2007.

Coal - Fatality Rates CY 2000 - 2007




- The Fatality Rate in Coal mines declined 25 percent from .0393 in CY 2000 to .0293 in CY 2007.
- The Fatality Rate in Coal mines increased 43 percent from .0205 in CY 2005 to .0293 in CY 2007.

- The Fatality Rate in MNM mines declined 32 percent from .0218 in CY 2000 to .0149 in CY 2007.
- The Fatality Rate in MNM mines declined 12 percent from .0170 in CY 2005 to .0149 in CY 2007.
