

## All MSHA - Fatality Rates CY 2000 - 2008




- The Fatality Rate decreased 44 percent from .0272 in CY 2000 to .0153 in CY 2008.
- The Fatality Rate decreased 30 percent from .0220 in CY 2006 to .0153 in CY 2008.

## Coal - Fatality Rates CY 2000 - 2008




- The Fatality Rate for Coal mines decreased 39 percent from .0393 in CY 2000 to .0238 in CY 2008.
- The Fatality Rate for Coal mines decreased 41 percent from .0400 in CY 2006 to .0238 in CY 2008.

# MSHA FACT SHEET: Mine Fatality Rate<sup>1</sup> Metal/Non Metal Mines CY 2000 - CY 2008

## M/NM - Fatality Rates CY 2000 - 2008



- The Fatality Rate for MNM mines decreased 53 percent from .0218 in CY 2000 to .0103 in CY 2008.
- The Fatality Rate for MNM mines decreased 16 percent from .0122 in CY 2006 to .0103 in CY 2008.
