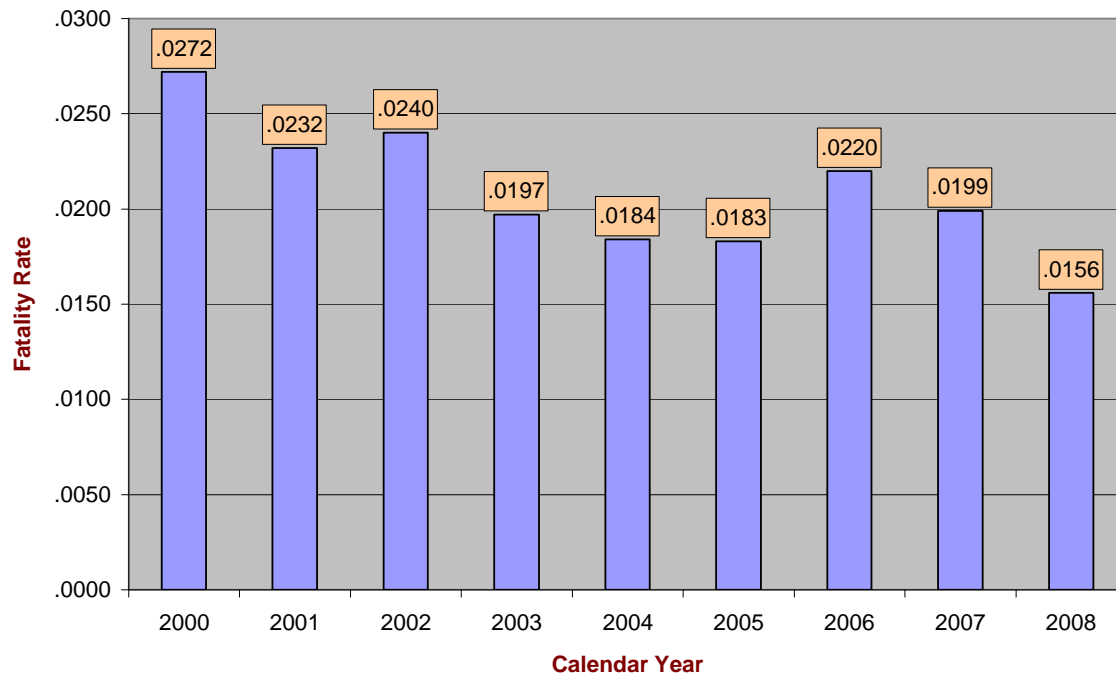


MSHA FACT SHEET: Mine Fatality Rate¹ Both Coal and Metal/Non Metal Mines CY 2000 - CY 2008

All MSHA - Fatality Rates CY 2000 - 2008

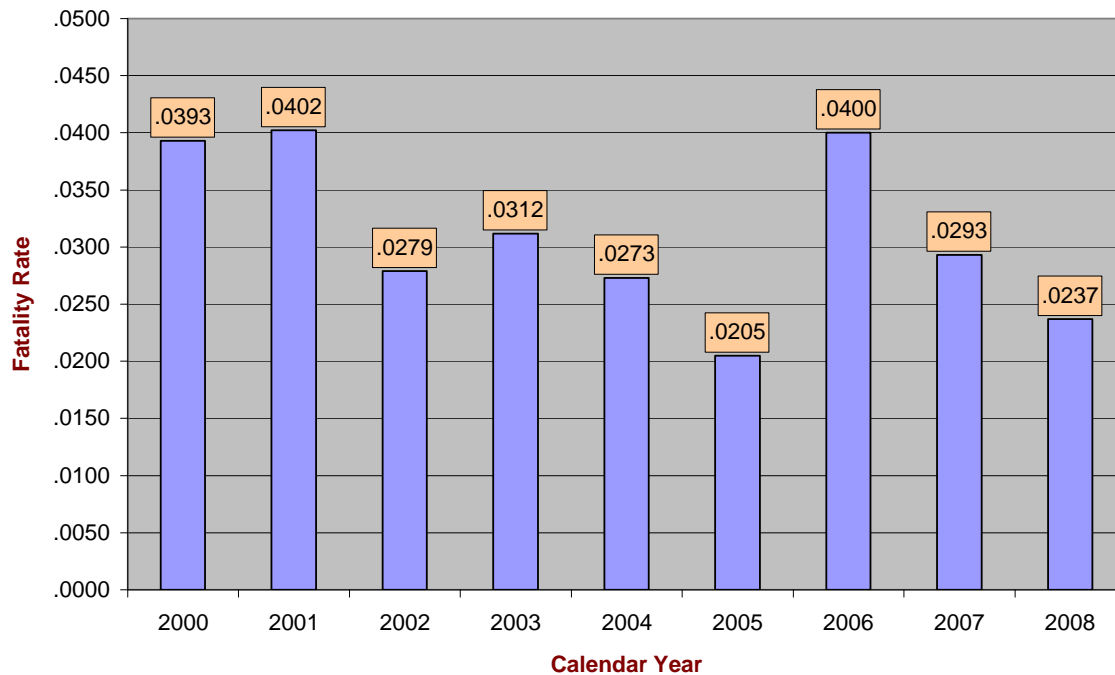


- The Fatality Rate decreased 43 percent from .0272 in CY 2000 to .0156 in CY 2008.
- The Fatality Rate decreased 29 percent from .0220 in CY 2006 to .0156 in CY 2008.

Coal - Fatality Rates CY 2000 - 2008

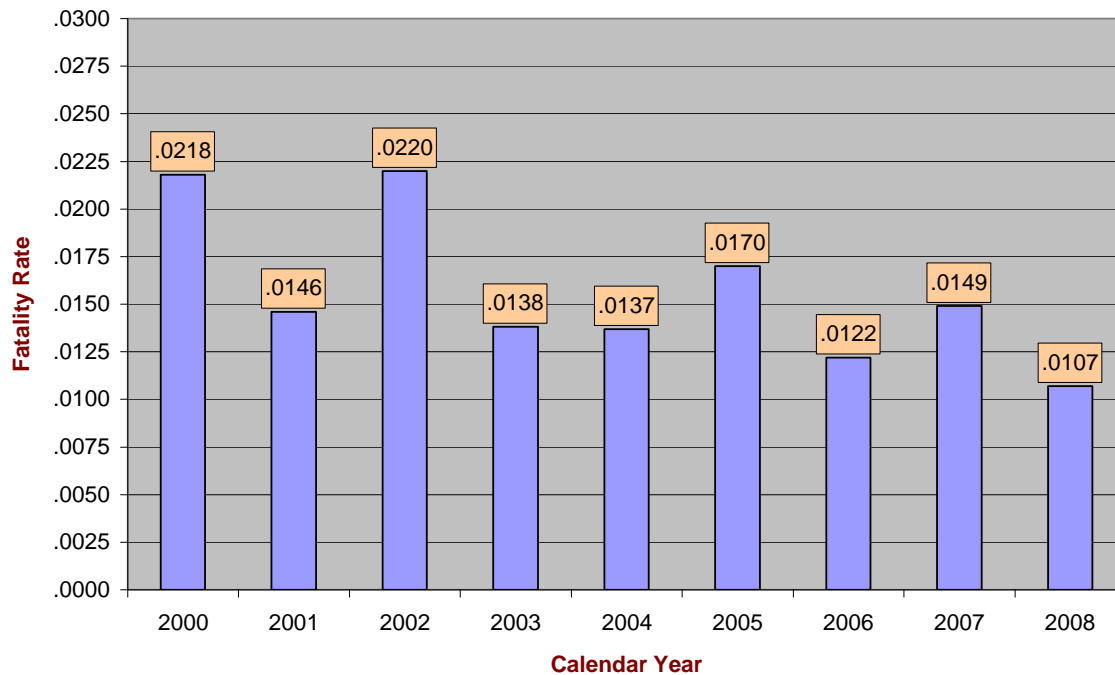


- The Fatality Rate for Coal mines decreased 40 percent from .0393 in CY 2000 to .0237 in CY 2008.
- The Fatality Rate for Coal mines decreased 41 percent from .0400 in CY 2006 to .0237 in CY 2008.

M/NM - Fatality Rates CY 2000 - 2008



- The Fatality Rate for MNM mines decreased 51 percent from .0218 in CY 2000 to .0107 in CY 2008.
- The Fatality Rate for MNM mines decreased 12 percent from .0122 in CY 2006 to .0107 in CY 2008.
