Sec. 50.10 Immediate notification.

The operator shall immediately contact MSHA at once without delay and within 15 minutes at the toll-free number, 1-800-746-1553, once the operator knows or should know that an accident has occurred involving:

- (a) A death of an individual at the mine;
- (b) An injury of an individual at the mine which has a reasonable potential to cause death;
- (c) An entrapment of an individual at the mine which has a reasonable potential to cause death; **or**
- (d) Any other accident**

I disapprove of the addition of (d), why should we have to report a incident that is just a 1st aid or recordable injury because of a prescription given to an employee, and be afraid of receiving a \$5,000.00 fine? Does not MSHA have any end to the fleecing of America and its mining companies, if MSHA keeps up there will not be any mining companies left.
