

BE CAREFUL!

Underground mines can have hidden shafts that drop hundreds of feet down.

Tunnels are prone to cave-ins and may contain deadly gases, flooded sections, and poisonous snakes. Unused or misfired explosives can be set off by the slightest disturbance.

Water-Filled Quarries are the mines that claim the most lives every year. The water is dangerously cold and deep. Quarries have slippery slopes and unstable rock ledges and may conceal old machinery and sharp objects.

Surface mines, popular spots for ATV and motorcycle enthusiasts, contain hills of loose materials or refuse.
