SUBJECT:	Expiration Dates for Program Directives and Directives Cancellations

#### Scope

This Program Information Bulletin (PIB) is for all MSHA Program directives holders within MSHA, mine operators, independent contractors, miners' representatives, and other interested parties.

#### Purpose

The purpose of this PIB is to rescind PIB P14-04, dated June 5, 2014, and to re-establish MSHA procedure of assigning expiration dates to Program Policy Letters (PPLs) and Procedure Instruction Letters (PILs). This PIB also transmits cancellation of directives.

#### Information

PIB P14-04, dated June 5, 2014, removed expiration dates for all PPLs and PILs in effect at the time and published since.

This PIB restores a policy that assigns expiration dates for PPLs and PILs. All PPLs and PILs in effect as of the issue date of this PIB will expire on March 31, 2021, regardless of their publication date. PPLs and PILs issued after the publication of this PIB will expire on March 31 of the second year following the effective date. PPLs and PILs are also revalidated each year prior to March 31. PIBs, while not assigned expiration dates, are reviewed and remain in effect as long as they are relevant.

Ninety (90) days prior to the expiration, the responsible program office will initiate review of the PPLs and PILs to determine if the guidance should be reissued without change, renewed with revisions, incorporated in the Program Policy Manual (PPM) or procedural handbook (handbook), or cancelled.

MSHA reviewed all existing PPLs, PILs and PIBs to determine whether these directives were still valid. This PIB identifies the PPLs that have been incorporated into the PPM, as well as the PPLs, PILs and PIBs that have been cancelled. MSHA's actions are listed

in the attachment. PPLs incorporated into the PPM will be cancelled upon publication of the revised PPM. The remaining PPLs, PILs, and PIBs listed in the attached will be cancelled upon publication of this PIB.

# Background

Volume II, Chapter 100 of MSHA's Administrative Policy and Procedures Manual outlines MSHA Directives System and defines the purpose, responsibilities, structure, and procedures involved in the formulation, distribution, and maintenance of directives within the Agency. The Directives System also describes the procedures for assigning expiration dates to PPLs and PILs, which are reiterated in the Information paragraph above, as well as the procedures used to periodically review and update directives.

The Federal Mine Safety and Health Act of 1977 [30 U.S.C. 801 et seq.] as amended by the Mine Improvement and New Emergency Response Act of 2006 ("MINER Act") [Pub. L. 109-236].
