Screening

Screening takes about 30 minutes and includes:

- Chest X-ray
- Lung function Testing (spirometry)
- Blood pressure screening
- Work history and respiratory health questionnaires



Health Report

Receive answers to your health-related questions and advice for a healthy working environment.

Test results are kept confidential to protect your privacy.

NIOSH will provide your results directly to you by mail and can also send results to your doctor after you sign a release form.
