Speak up, save lives MSHA has your back

To report a hazardous condition that could cause a serious accident, injury, illness or fatality call 1-800-746-1553 or report it online at msha.gov.

AS A MINER, YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO:

- Be given effective health and safety training.
- Be protected from discrimination for exercising your rights.
- File or make a complaint of danger, or safety or health violation to a federal or state agency, a mine operator, an operator's agent or a miners' representative.
- Refuse to work in conditions you believe are unsafe, unhealthy, or illegal (after notifying the operator of the condition and giving them an opportunity to address the situation).
- A medical evaluation or to be considered for transfer to another job location because of harmful physical agents and toxic substances.
- Exercise any rights afforded by the Mine Act.
- Select a representative for safety and health purposes.
