












Current Control Technologies in Metal and Nonmetal Mines

- Exhaust Aftertreatment Systems:
 - Scrubbers:
 - Water or dry scrubbers
 - DPF Filters:
 - DPM:
 - Paper
 - Sintered Metal
 - Ceramic
 - -Catalyzed or uncatalyzed diesel particulate filters
 - Exhaust Gases:
 - Oxidation catalytic converters i.e. diesel oxidation catalysts



Current Control Technologies in Metal and Nonmetal Mines (2)

- ▶ Selective Catalytic Reduction: Diesel exhaust fluid/Urea Injection
- ▶ Low Emission Engines
- ▶ Environmental Cabs on Mobile Equipment
- Ventilation
 - Passive/Active



▶ Fuel, Fuel Additives, Alternative Fuel:

- Ultra low sulfur diesel (ULSD: < 15 ppm sulfur fuels)</p>
- Fuel additives:
 - Cetane improvers
 - Oxygenated additives
 - Detergents
 - Dispersants or surfactants
- Biodiesel
 - -5% biodiesel blend to 100%
