The application period for this competitive grant program is July 23 - August 23, 2018. MSHA is distributing up to \$250,000 in grant funds to states, territorial, and tribal governments, and private or public nonprofit entities.

Established by the Mine Improvement and New Emergency Response (MINER) Act of 2006, the program promotes mine safety in honor of the 25 miners who died in 2001 in Brookwood, Alabama, at the Jim Walter Resources #5 mine, and in 2006 in Buckhannon, West Virginia, at the Sago Mine.

Grantees will use the funds to provide education and training programs on powered haulage safety, examinations of working places at metal and nonmetal mines, or mine emergency prevention and preparedness.
