Microsoft Visio is sold as an addition to MS Office. Visio 2019 - the latest version - comes in three editions: Visio Standard, Visio Professional, and Visio Pro for Office 365. The current pricing is around \$280 for the Standard version and \$530 for the Professional version. If you can find Visio 2010, 2013, 2016, they will work fine for use with MR problem design and Team contest use.

Some teams might have Visio 2010 version. These older versions will work fine with what we are doing in MR. Problem designers just need to make sure and save the CCA key maps in *.vsd format. By default Visio 2016 will save as a *.vsdx file format.

Once the Team, BO, CCA maps are created as a Visio file, they can be resaved as a JPEG or PDF for review by people who do not have Visio on their computer.
