**CASH (Compliance Assistance in Safety and Health)** is a new MSHA initiative designed to support **new mines, mine operators, and miners** as they begin operations. CASH helps you understand MSHA requirements, connect with experts, and build a strong safety culture from day one.

Whether you're opening a new mine, hiring new workers, or expanding your operation, **CASH gives you the tools to operate safely and in compliance.**

## Who is CASH for?

1. **New mine operators**
2. **Inexperienced miners** (less than one year of experience)
3. **Newly hired experienced miners**
4. **Industry and state agency partners supporting new operations**
