2019 Mine Health and Safety Training Materials Competition

Training Resources Applied to Mining (TRAM) Seminar October 15-17, 2019

Deadline for Receipt of Entries: Friday, August 15, 2019

LATE/INCOMPLETE ENTRIES MAY BE DISQUALIFIED. SUBMITTED ENTRIES ARE NOT RETURNED.

PLEASE NOTE

Your entry must include a copy in electronic format (CD/DVD/flash drive). This will enable TRAM attendees to view your entry on a computer set up specifically for this purpose during the Seminar.

MSHA Blue Ribbon awards will be presented to the competition winners during the TRAM Opening Ceremony.

Winning entries will be copied to discs and distributed to TRAM attendees following the presentation of awards.

I. WHO CAN ENTER?

The competition is open to all sources of mining-related training materials.

II. WHAT TYPES OF MATERIAL ARE ELIGIBLE?

Original health and safety training materials that you have developed or majorly revised since the 2018 TRAM Seminar are eligible. Entries cannot include the use of copyrighted materials, and you must be willing to share your entry with the mining community. Materials should address pertinent training requirements outlined in Title 30 of the Code of Federal Regulations (30 CFR) Parts 1-199, including Part 75 – Subpart P – Mine Emergencies.

1. As a change for the 2019 Safety Materials Competition, entries will not be divided into categories. All entries will be evaluated according to the same criteria. The evaluation criteria have been simplified to streamline the process for entrants. Entries demonstrating an acceptable level of excellence will be awarded an MSHA Blue Ribbon.

We reserve the right to disqualify late and/or incomplete entries.

- 2. You may submit multiple entries.
- 3. A completed Entry Submittal Document (Part II, attached) must accompany each entry.

Be sure to include a copy of your materials in electronic format. *NOTE:* Do not expect the judging team to assume any of the information requested in the form.

III. HOW WILL ENTRIES BE EVALUATED?

A team of judges will assemble to evaluate each entry. The judges will perform a critical evaluation of **two crucial elements required of each entry**:

Element #1: Part II - Entry Submittal Document

• Is the required Entry Submittal Document complete?

Element #2: The Training Material

- Is the training material user-friendly?
- Is it legible/easily understood?
- Is the material well-organized?
- Are all elements of the material readily accessible?
- Is the content current?
- Is the material technically accurate?
- Has the developer clearly articulated training objectives?
- Is the material relevant to the stated target audience(s)?
- Are the images/handouts clear, legible, and easily understood?
- Is the sound (if used) clear and easily understood?
- Are animations (if used) relevant and easily understood?
- Does this material make users more aware of the hazards associated with their job and appropriate hazard controls?
- Did this training trigger a behavior-altering response from users?

IV. WHAT BECOMES OF MY SUBMITTED TRAINING MATERIALS?

The training materials submitted for the 2019 Mine Health and Safety Training Materials Competition will not be returned. The Mine Safety and Health Administration (MSHA) has the rights to use, duplicate, and/or distribute these submitted materials. Blue Ribbon entries will be on display at the Safety Materials Competition booth throughout the TRAM Seminar.

V. WHAT HAPPENS IF I WIN?

Winners of the Training Materials Competition are determined by the judges' evaluation prior to the beginning of the TRAM Seminar. All winners will be announced and presented with awards during the Opening Ceremony on Tuesday, October 15, 2019. Each participant will receive a Certificate of Appreciation. Entries demonstrating an acceptable level of excellence will be presented with an MSHA Blue Ribbon.

VI. HOW DO I SUBMIT MY ENTRY (ENTRIES)?

You may submit more than one entry. Each entry must include a **completed Part II Entry Submittal Document**, meet all of these requirements, and arrive at the following address by close of business on **August 15**, **2019**:
