

2022 FREE NIOSH BLACK LUNG SCREENING for COAL MINERS

NIOSH's Mobile Occupational Safety and Health Unit will be in your area soon to conduct black lung screenings. All coal miners are encouraged to stop by the mobile and participate in this free health exam. The exam takes about 15 minutes and includes a short questionnaire, a chest radiograph, and blood pressure screening.

Miners are urged to call **1-888-480-4042 to schedule an appointment** to ensure a time spot due to reduced capacity related to the ongoing pandemic. Depending on the number of miners participating, some wait time should be anticipated.

NOTE: If you have participated in the NIOSH Program within the past 3 years, you will NOT be eligible to receive a chest radiograph at this time. However, you may still qualify for spirometry.
