Discuss common hazards, develop procedures for more thorough workplace and equipment examinations, and provide more detailed training sessions. **Keep these best practices in mind to *Take Time, Save Lives*:**

OWNERS/OPERATORS: How can you improve safety and health programs, equipment, and hazard reporting to make them more effective?

SUPERVISORS: How can you improve training and examinations? Have you addressed any concerns raised prior to your shift?

MINERS: Do you have properly fitting protective equipment and are you fully trained on any equipment you are operating?
